"When I became a shop steward, I discovered this whole other side to being in a union: negotiating with the employers here in the factory but also negotiating collective agreements for the company. But to achieve that, you need solidarity, not only between workers at this site but between all the workers in the group. This is how we eventually got a 36-hour week. It was tough, we were on strike for five weeks, but we won it and it's been great for our wellbeing." Federico, Belgium, glass worker
